## SCTD Projects

1. Transit Vehicle Preventive Maintenance  
Grant Request: \$120,000

- Operating in Clackamas County since 1989
  - Serving a large rural area of 100 square miles, with a population in excess of 20,000
- 4 Routes Serving:
  - Clackamas Community College (5:00am – 8:30pm, M-F; 8am – 5:00pm, Sat)
  - Canby Area Transit Center (6:30am – 6:15pm, M-F)
  - City of Molalla (8:30am – 5:30pm, M-F; 9:00am – 4pm, Sat)
  - City Express (10:00am – 5:00pm, M-F)
- Deviated Fixed-Route service open to the public
  - City Bus Route deviates from the regular fixed-route up to ¼ of a mile, curb to curb service with advanced reservation. Service is free.
  - \$1 fare for service to Canby and Clackamas Community College.



# 5310 Funding Goals

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- SCTD requests \$120,000 of 5310 funding for FY 27-29, this is a decrease of \$80,000 from the previous biennium to take into account reductions in available federal grant funding and reductions in ridership levels, we feel this is a reasonable request and the funds will be properly utilized over the 24 month period.
- The funding will be utilized to maintain the SCTD vehicle fleet in support of older adults and disabled riders within our service area.
- SCTD provided over 5,000 rides for older adults and disabled riders in FY 25.

# 5310 Circular

- ▶ The goal of the Section 5310 program is to improve mobility for seniors and individuals with disabilities throughout the country by removing barriers to transportation services and expanding the transportation mobility options available.
- ▶ Provision of transportation options that would not otherwise be available for seniors and individuals with disabilities measured in numbers of seniors and people with disabilities afforded mobility they would not have without program support.
- ▶ Traditional Section 5310 Projects: Those public transportation capital projects planned, designed, and carried out to meet the special needs of seniors and individuals with disabilities when public transportation is insufficient, inappropriate, or unavailable.

- ▶ Covers MHX, TRP, and Village Shuttle Fleets

  - ▶ Grant Amount: \$241,263
  - ▶ Match Amount: \$27,613 (STIF Funds)
